## WHO ARE WE?

Founded in 1983, Asian Americans Advancing Justice - Los Angeles (Advancing Justice - LA) is the nation's largest legal and civil rights organization for Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders. Every year, through legal advice or services, litigation, advocacy, training and other programs, we help thousands of individuals and groups while also building a strong voice for civil rights.

## WHAT DO WE DO?

Advancing Justice - LA provides free legal information on the telephone or in person. For select cases, we may also provide additional legal assistance or representation for free or at a low cost.

In addition, we offer free educational presentations, classes, and training on specific issues such as civics, English as Second Language (ESL), and leadership development.

## WHAT WILL WE DO AFTER YOU CALL?

Before Advancing Justice - LA can help you, we may have to do an "intake" to determine if you are eligible for our services. An intake worker will ask about your legal issue, income, family size, and other personal information. We will not share this information with anyone outside of our office.

Depending on your legal issue, we may provide legal information or advice on the phone. In certain cases, we may provide legal assistance or representation. If we cannot handle your issue, we will try to give you information about other legal groups to contact.
