Founded in 1983, Asian Americans Advancing Justice - Los Angeles is the nation's largest legal and civil rights organization for Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians, and Pacific Islanders. Every year, through legal advice or services, litigation, advocacy, training and other programs, we help thousands of individuals and groups while also building a strong voice for civil rights.

## WHAT DO WE DO?

Advancing Justice - LA provides free legal information, on the telephone or in person. For select cases, we may also provide additional legal assistance or representation. Some immigration assistance is available for a fee.

We also offer free educational presentations on many issues, and classes or trainings on specific issues such as civics and English as Second Language (ESL) or leadership development.

## WHAT WILL WE DO AFTER YOU CALL?

Before Advancing Justice-LA can help you, we may have to do an "intake" to determine if you are eligible for our services. Our intakes are done over the phone and we are required to ask about your income, family size, etc. We will not share this information with anyone outside of our office.

We will ask you about your legal problem. If we cannot handle your issue, we will try to give you information about other legal groups.

For some issues, we may provide you legal information or advice on the phone. For other issues, or in certain cases, we may provide legal assistance or representation.
