Citizenship Eligibility Requirements

- You are at least 18 years old
- You are a permanent resident (you have a green card)
- You have resided continuously in the U.S. for at least 5 years (or if you are married to a U.S. citizen, at least 3 years)
- You have been physically present in the U.S. for at least 2½ years (or if you are married to a U.S. citizen, at least 1½ years)
- You demonstrate good moral character
- You demonstrate a basic knowledge of U.S. history and government as well as an ability to read, write, speak and understand basic English

Information & documents to bring:

- Green card and state-issued ID
- Filing fee: **\$725** (if under 75 years of age) or **\$640** (if 75 or older), payable to "U.S. Department of Homeland Security." Note: If you are low-income, you may qualify for a **full or partial** fee waiver.
- Passport(s)
- Arrest and court records (if any)
- Home addresses for the past 5 years
- Employer addresses and employment dates for the past 5 years
- Dates of all trips abroad since you became a permanent resident
- Spouse and children names, birth dates, A-numbers, and addresses
